Remarks for 2015 Tournament

Introduction

Fellow bowlers and visitors,

We would like to extend a warm welcome to you all to Dunoon for the 68th Annual Dunoon Bowling Tournament. Let's hope for a week of warm and sunny weather – after the summer we've had to date it's more than overdue, so fingers crossed.

Before we go on to discuss this year's tournament and the changes we have made, we would like to turn our thoughts to last season, which was our first year at the reins. As always, the Scottish weather can play a big part in whether it's a good or indifferent week. Thankfully, it was very kind to us right up until Saturday's finals day. We would like to give a special thanks to Derek Logue and the members of Bogleha' Bowling Club, who worked hard to ensure we still had the spectacle of the tournament finals to enjoy. Can we also once again thank all the players, spectators, markers, umpires, caterers, greenkeepers, secretaries, photographers and anyone else who contributed to making 2014 a real success for the Harry Gordon. We are extremely proud to still have one of the most popular open tournaments in Scotland's bowling calendar. The changes which are discussed below, we hope will continue to grow the tournament and it's popularity in the years to come.

During last year's tournament we asked you all to complete a survey which covered many aspects of the tournament itself. This has given us a useful tool to steer the future direction of the Harry Gordon week. The subtle changes we introduced last year were popular, and we are continuing to alter some things this year. We will try and cover these briefly in this opening gambit so you all have an idea of what we have done.

Survey Feedback

1. Plate competition – this idea was very popular indeed. All first round losers in both singles and pairs would go into a 'plate' style knockout tournament running in parallel to the other events. This would guarantee all participants in any competition a minimum of two games. The plate finals would be held on the Saturday morning and would have prize money, but no trophy. We are almost certain to introduce this next year, however there will be a requirement to increase entry fees from the current levels of £6 singles and £12 for pairs. For comparison, we understand it is £10 and £20 for similar tournaments in Scotland – which are still straight knockouts, with no free plate competition. The reason we didn't introduce this immediately was to prevent frightening off players with fee increases without knowing fully our direction.

2. Entry fees – it was felt by a large number of you that this tournament is a very inexpensive tournament week and that most players would be happy to pay a bit more, especially if point 1 above was introduced. Therefore, we will have to increase entry fees to help pay for these additional prize funds. What exactly these will be we will calculate at the end of this season and communicate and explain to you with next year's entry forms. Rest assured we do not make increases to make any profit.
3. Introduction of triples – it was felt there was already enough to do with the singles, pairs and the evening activities at the clubs without introducing more to the week. We will not be introducing a gents or ladies triples competition.
4. Prize money changes – we altered the prize money last year to be fairer and more in line with the number of entries received in each competition. We did not receive a single objection to this.
5. Consolation mixed pairs and triples – the mixed pairs was, as always a popular and well supported consolation tournament. The triples continues to be very poorly supported such that once again, there wasn't enough interest to proceed with it. We have decided to put the consolation mixed triples competition to one side for the time being unless we feel there is just reason to re-introduce it. The consolation mixed pairs will now also be open to anyone who wishes to enter (other than those still competing). This allows those that cannot play in other events due to other commitments to compete for a trophy.

Other Changes

We have also come up with a few changes of our own this year that we feel might benefit the tournament. We're trying them this year, and we will gauge their popularity and make adjustments if necessary. We are aware not all of them will necessarily be popular – but we are trying to shape the future for the majority not the minority.

1. This year we have drastically altered the green's timetable. We felt that by using all five greens over the period Monday to Thursday puts unnecessary pressure on all the local clubs to have not only the green prepared for play, but to provide markers, umpires, bar staff and catering. This seems a bit much when a club might only host six singles matches at 10am and four to six pairs matches at 2pm.
This year we are trying a new setup whereby all the games on Monday and Tuesday will be at three greens and only two greens on the Wednesday and Thursday.
We feel this will benefit all the clubs so that they are not having to open and provide catering every day of the tournament. Also, there will be more of an 'atmosphere' at each club as there will be more players and visitors per club. This idea was discussed with all Cowal clubs during the close season and they have all supported it.

We know this puts an added strain on each club, mainly in terms of markers – which gets harder every year. But that is where we all the local bowlers have to make the effort to attend the hosting clubs on each day and provide their services – particularly when it comes to marking. We cannot stress that point enough – the clubs put a lot of work into to making this a great week for our visitors, the least we can do as hosts is rally round the greens that have matches rather than just turning up to play.

Due to these changes the playing timetable does look a bit messy on the Monday, but this is due to the limited rinks at each green and allowing players time to travel between venues. Also, there will be players who will be on the same green twice on the Thursday – but this is unavoidable. However, normal rules will apply and no-one will be allowed on the same rink twice in the one day.

2. We have increased the number of ends in all gents and ladies pairs matches to 17. It used to be 15 until the final. However, this is somewhat out dated now and 17 is in line with Bowls Scotland pairs competitions. The mixed pairs will have separate rules detailed on that page.
3. Those with eagle eyes when completing our entry form will hopefully have noticed the address for our brand new tournament website (www.dunoonopenbowls.com) which went live earlier this year. We will be publishing the full draw on the website as well as keeping it completely up to date as the week progresses. We will also provide minor updates and photos on the very popular Facebook group: 'Cowal Outdoor Bowling Community.'

Juniors

It's also worth noting that Friday as always sees the juniors take part in their qualifying event at Bogleha' for their right to stake a claim in Saturday's Jimmy Ridell final. It's always a great spectacle to see the kids playing, so we hope some of you can come down to assist with marking and cheering them on.

General

There are also plenty of events you can get involved in during the evenings, and we would hope you will support all the clubs in their endeavours to provide something for you to enjoy during the week. We have included a list of the evening activities that we know about to date, as well as information on how to enter or get tickets. Please support as many of these as you can.

We would also like to encourage you all to utilise text messaging where possible during the week if you need to communicate with us. We are both playing in the tournament as usual, so will not always be able to take phone calls, therefore we have provide our contact details later in the handbook.

Many of you are local or returning bowlers to the tournament, but there are also a few new faces who are returning to the Harry Gordon week after many years and we would like to extend an extra special welcome to them. We hope you will find the hospitality and friendship at all the Cowal greens something to remember and that you will return to play with us again in the future.

Finally, as we all know the success of the tournament can be affected by mother nature, we will try our best to communicate promptly with all the clubs should inclement weather have an effect on the match scheduling.

Good luck to you all and here's to another great week on and off the bowling green!

Tournament Notes

This list whilst not exhaustive should provide you all with the guidance you need:

- Play will be conducted in accordance with the rules of World Bowls, Crystal Mark, 3rd Edition.
- No double entries are permitted.
- Any player or team not reporting **within 30 minutes** of their starting time will automatically be disqualified.
- Anyone reaching the semi-finals of the gents singles, ladies singles, gents pairs or ladies pairs **cannot** participate in the mixed pairs.
- Anyone can take part in this year's nominated mixed pairs whether they have competed in the other main events or not. Those players who are still competing in either singles or pairs after 5.00pm on Thursday are not permitted to play in the mixed pairs.
- Presentation of trophies will be approximately 4.45pm on Saturday 3rd August at Kirn & Hunter's Quay Bowling Club.
- In the event that the finals cannot be completed on the Saturday, the organisers will discuss the options with the competing players before any decision is taken.
- All singles matches will be first to 21 shots.
- All gents and ladies pairs matches will be 17 ends throughout the competition. Two trial ends are permitted if desired.
- The tournament directors reserve the right to alter or amend any ruling. Their decision is final.
